

CPP20218 - CERTIFICATE II IN SECURITY OPERATIONS

FOR SA SECURITY LICENSING ENDORSEMENTS

COURSE PURPOSE: To prepare participants for licensing as **General Security Guard and Crowd/Venue Controller** to ensure graduates are at a professional “work ready” standard for employment within the security industry. This course is also a pre-requisite for “Guarding with a Firearm” licence under the new security course package/s rules announced by the National Regulator (ASQA) in Jan 2019.

This course also includes First Aid, Defensive Tactics (Empty Hand Techniques), RSA and Fire Safety & Emergency Procedures. A module on “Terrorism Awareness in Australia” is also included in the course program.

COURSE PRE-REQUISITES: Persons wishing to apply for a security licence need to be “fit and proper persons” to obtain a licence. Persons with certain types of criminal convictions or those that are “close associate” of criminals and those that are subject to Control Orders, Mental Health Orders or Firearms Prohibition Orders may not be eligible for licensing.

Suitability to hold a security licence will be assessed by Consumer and Business Services (CBS) once training is completed and a security licence application is lodged with them. State Government application and licensing fees apply. Marksman Security Training has no influence as to whether CBS refuses to grant a licence and therefore is not liable to refund course fees accepted in good faith.

PRECOURSE INTERVIEWS & LLN ASSESSMENTS: Pre - course interviews are conducted before enrolment to assess the applicant’s ability to be able to achieve the required standard of course work and their general suitability for the security industry.

It is recommended that applicants have a good standard of general health and fitness to suit industry requirements. Individual security employers have their own individual fitness requirements as well and may require pre-employment medical examinations.

It is also recommended that applicants have Literacy & Numeracy skills at AQF3. An LLN assessment is conducted as part of the pre-course interview to ensure applicants can complete the required course work.

The ability to read, write and speak English fluently is mandatory.

Applicants are strongly advised that most employers will also need them to hold a current SA driver's licence as part of their employment.

COURSE OUTLINE: The CPP20218 - Certificate II in Security Operations course has 14 mandatory units of competency that need to be completed to qualify for “**General guarding & Crowd/venue control**” security industry licenses in SA. There are no electives in this course package.

This qualification reflects the various roles of the security officer, responsibilities for maintaining safety and security by patrolling, protecting or guarding property **while unarmed**, and screening of persons and vehicles, monitoring crowd behaviour and removing persons from premises where required.

It also provides a pathway for further learning and work in various security roles and settings for example armed guarding, cash in transit, close protection and guard dog handling.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CPP20218 - CERTIFICATE II IN SECURITY OPERATIONS

CORE UNITS:

- CPPSEC2101 - Apply effective communication skills to maintain security
- CPPSEC2102 - Apply legal and procedural requirements to work effectively within a security team
- CPPSEC2103 - Apply WHS, emergency response and evacuation procedures to maintain security
- CPPSEC2104 - Apply risk assessment to select and carryout response to security risk situations
- CPPSEC2105 - Provide quality services to a range of security clients
- CPPSEC2106 - Protect self and others using basic defensive techniques
- CPPSEC2107 - Patrol premises to monitor property and maintain security
- CPPSEC2108 - Screen people, personal effects and items to maintain security
- CPPSEC2109 - Monitor and control access to and exit of persons and vehicles from premises
- CPPSEC2110 - Monitor and control individual and crowd behaviour to maintain security
- CPPSEC2111 - Apply security procedures to manage intoxicated persons
- CPPSEC2112 - Apply security procedures to remove persons from premises
- CPPSEC2113 - Escort and protect persons and valuables
- HLTAID003 - Provide first aid

Note:

Under the new package guidelines persons wishing to apply for “Guarding with a firearm” endorsement on their security licence will need to complete CPP20218 - Certificate II in Security Operations and hold a current security licence and then complete CPPSEC3114 - Control security risk using firearms” and related Unit/s.

COURSE DURATION:

The course is completed by “blended mode” and completed through a combination of external study plus a **6 days full time attendance** module which includes all theory and practical skills training & assessment sessions and First Aid training. Additional hours of off-site study and project work in addition to the attendance component are required to successfully complete this course.

COURSE FEES:

Course Fee is \$895

AWARDS: Successful students will be awarded **“CPP20218 - Certificate II in Security Operations”** - minimum requirement for this award is to complete **mandatory** 14 units of competency. There are no electives included in the new course package.

TRAINING PROGRAM

This course program is completed through “blended” mode only. The attendance module of the course is delivered between 0930 and 1700 Mon to Fri on the days scheduled. The course daily program is issued on the first day of the course.
