

CPP31418 CERTIFICATE III IN CLOSE PROTECTION

8 CORE UNITS PLUS 6 ELECTIVE UNITS



COURSE PURPOSE: The course is designed to qualify persons in the role of close protection operatives that are responsible for providing security services to protect the safety and security of principals (clients) that may be celebrities, political figures, very important persons (VIP's) or other persons requiring close protection services.

This qualification is required for the SA Security Licence Endorsement “Body Guarding as an employee”

COURSE PRE-REQUISITES:

There are no formal pre-requisites for this qualification, however it is strongly recommended that candidates will have completed CPP20218 - Certificate 11 in Security Operations or equivalent.

Note: Candidates will need a current Driver's Licence to complete this course.

PRECOURSE INTERVIEWS & LLN ASSESSMENTS: Pre - course interviews are conducted before enrolment to assess applicant's ability and suitability to undertake this course. An LLN assessment is also conducted as part of the pre-course interview to ensure applicants can complete the require course work. LLN is assessed at AQF3.

COURSE OUTLINE: This course covers the competencies that need to be completed at Certificate III in Security Operations level **See below.**

COURSE DURATION:

The course is completed by blended mode through a combination of external study plus a **10 days full time attendance** module which includes all theory and practical skills training & assessment sessions.

COURSE FEES: The course fee is **\$1295** for the full 10 day course program

AWARD: Successful students will be awarded **"CPP31418 - Certificate III in Close Protection"** - minimum requirement for this award is 8 core and 6 elective units

TRAINING PROGRAM

The 10 day F/T attendance component of the course is delivered between 0930 and 1700 Mon to Fri on the days scheduled. The attendance course daily program is issued on the first day.
