

SECURITY INDUSTRY FIREARMS (H6) LICENSING COURSE

FOR SA SECURITY LICENSING ENDORSEMENTS “GUARDING WITH A FIREARM- EMPLOYEE”

CPPSEC3114 - Control security risk situations using firearms,

CPPSEC3115 - Carry, operate and maintain revolvers for security purposes

CPPSEC3116 - Carry, operate and maintain semi-automatic pistols for security purposes



COURSE PURPOSE: This course is designed to comply with SA Police Security Firearms (H6) training requirements and the requirements of Consumer & Business Services (SA) “Guarding with a Firearm” licence requirements.

Once qualified graduates will be able to work for security companies that are licensed to perform armed guarding work such as Armoured or “soft skin” Cash in Transit (CIT) work and other similar high-risk security guarding work.

COURSE PRE-REQUISITES: Applicants must:

1. Have completed CPP20218 - Certificate II in Security Operations or hold a current “General Guarding as an employee” licence.
2. Be of or over 18 years of age.
3. Have a current SAPD police “letter of approval” letter approving them to undertake H6 firearms training. This requires that the applicant apply for a H6 Security Firearms Licence via SA Police. The SA Police will conduct the required background checks and then if the applicant is suitable, issue a “letter of approval” to the applicant.
4. Be physically and mentally fit to be able to complete the course training requirements.
5. Have passed pre-course firearms assessment with Marksman Security Training. (For details - see below)

COURSE OUTLINE: This course covers the Units of Competency CPPSEC3114 - Control security risk situations using firearms, CPPSEC3115 - Carry, operate and maintain revolvers for security purposes and CPPSEC3116 - Carry, operate and maintain semi-automatic pistols for security purposes

It also includes the SA Police H6 Security Firearms Training requirement for security industry firearms licensing in SA. This 5-day course program covers Uniformed Carry firearms only.

Concealed Carry training is completed as a separate 1day training program if required.

COURSE DURATION: 5 days Full time - 0845hr to 1630hr Mon - Fri inclusive.

FOR SA SECURITY LICENCE: GUARDING WITH A FIREARM AS AN EMPLOYEE (SA)

SA Consumer & Business Services requires that the applicant will need to hold CPP20218 - Certificate II in Security Operations or have an existing SA security licence with the "general guarding" endorsement.

Note: CBS have advised that "if you already hold a security agent licence for General Guarding or General Guarding as an employee, only the CPPSEC3114 Unit is required" This was advised on 4 Sep 19. The two additional firearms related units must be completed as well.

TRAINING PROGRAM

This course program is completed through attendance modes only. The course is delivered between 0845 and 1630 Mon to Fri on the days scheduled. The course daily program is issued on the first day of the course.

This firearms component of this course may only be completed through Full Time attendance only at our training centre which has a 20 metre indoor firearms range located on the premises.

PRE-COURSE ASSESSMENT (H6 FIREARMS LICENCE TRAINING COURSE)

Persons that wish to undertake the H6 Security Firearms Licence Course need to undertake a pre-course assessment to determine suitability and aptitude for the full course program. The assessment will take around one hour to complete.

Applicants will need to produce a SAPOL Firearms Training "letter of approval" prior to undertaking this assessment.

This process is designed to prevent students that are not likely to meet the full course theoretical and practical standards from wasting their valuable time and money.

The cost of the assessment is \$100. This will help cover the cost of ammunition, firearm wear and tear and instructor time required to conduct the assessment. This fee is taken off the price of the full firearms course fee for those that are accepted onto the 5 day H6 firearms training course.

FULL TRAINING COURSE FEES: \$1895 (including up to 400 rds of ammunition for each of the semi-automatic pistol and revolvers used on the course) Course fees also include the use of our duty equipment and firearms.
